The first models to be launched are the SPMA - 3.2 and 3.5 t electromechanical 2-post lifts with asymmetric configuration, designed to lift vehicles ranging from micro cars to medium-size vans with long wheel base.

Pioneering innovation

The Tomorrow series is introduced to the market as a reliable and powerful lift able to sustain high performance even in demanding conditions.

The series distinguishes itself for:

• up to 20% less installation time. Electronic synchronisation prevents installation and adjustment of the realignment cable. Furthermore, the three width-adjustable positions allow the lifts to be flexibly installed;




